**SUBJECT:** Spring Ceremonial Parade and General Information for May 17-18, 2019

Enclosed is a Schedule of Events and map for our Spring Ceremonial to be held in Rocky Mount, NC.

The Candidates Committee and Medical Staff should report to Nash Community College (Science & Technology Building), for registration at 522 N. Old Carriage Rd., Rocky Mount, NC, Saturday, May 18, 7:00am.

The Provost Guard will furnish four (4) men to assist with handling the Candidates and report to Noble Tom Rice, Director of Candidates at 7:15am on Saturday at Nash Community College (Science & Technology Building) for the Registration of Candidates which starts at 7:30am. The Provost Guard will police the Business Meeting (8:00 am) and First Section (10:00 am) at the Nash Community College and Second Section (Nash Community College – Gymnasium). They are to be on hand to attend the doors at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled events and to check 2019 Members dues cards.

The Ritualistic Cast should report for set up with the First Section commencing at 10:00am at the Nash Community College (Science & Technology Building).

Uniform Units will not have any special duties to perform at the Business Meeting or Second Section, except for the Patrol's Color Guard to post colors and the Provost Guard to provide security. All nobles are urged to attend the Stated Business Meeting on Saturday 8:00 am at the Nash Community College (Science & Technology Building).

Parades---Uniform Units can start lining up at 11:00am with step off at 12:00am. Line up in Nashville, NC – Corner of E Cedar St. and N 1<sup>st</sup> St. Parade steps off on E Cedar St. In accordance with the Board of Directors, the following guideline is still in effect with regards to Shrine parades: No Trailers Shall Participate in Parades.

**It's very important to keep marching cadence at 110 steps to the minute and 40 feet between units are to be constantly maintained. The Winter Ceremonial parade had so many gaps, the crowd thought the parade was over. Please be cognizant of this at all times.**

The Wrecking Crew Director is requested to submit list descriptions of stunts for approval to Potentate Carl Smith and Director Frank Long with a copy to Recorder George Raecher 15 days prior to Ceremonial. The Second Section is to be held at the Nash Community College (Gymnasium) starting at 2:30pm.

Moslem Feast/Chef Crew---The Moslem Feast immediately follows the parade and is held at the Nash Central High School (4279 Nash Central High Rd.). All nobles and ladies are invited to attend. Candidates, Divan, Past Potentates, Distinguished Guests, and Uniform Unit members who have a part in the Second Section may go to head of the serving line, to ensure that they have sufficient time to report for opening of Second Section. The Second Section is to be held in at 2:30pm at Nash Community College (Gymnasium). The Camel Drivers may set up their Jewelry / Merchandise on Friday and Saturday.

Members of participating units shall not drink any alcoholic beverages before or during any parade, and they shall be circumspect in the use of soft drinks in public places so as not to give the impression they are drinking alcoholic beverages.

Each Uniform Unit Head is requested to check each member of his Unit to be sure they have a 2019 dues card. If anyone has any questions, do not hesitate to call the office or me. As always, your help is greatly appreciated.

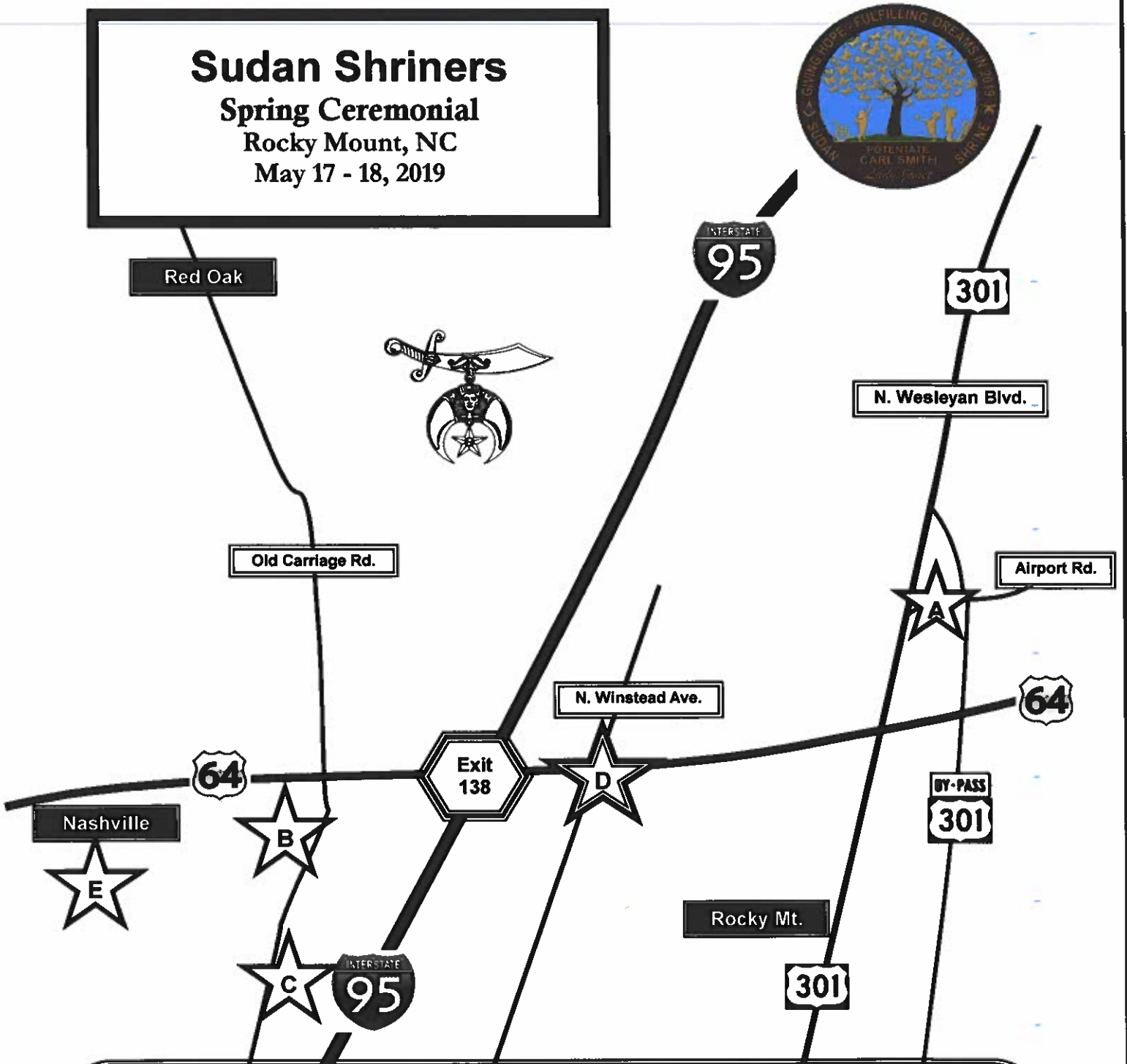

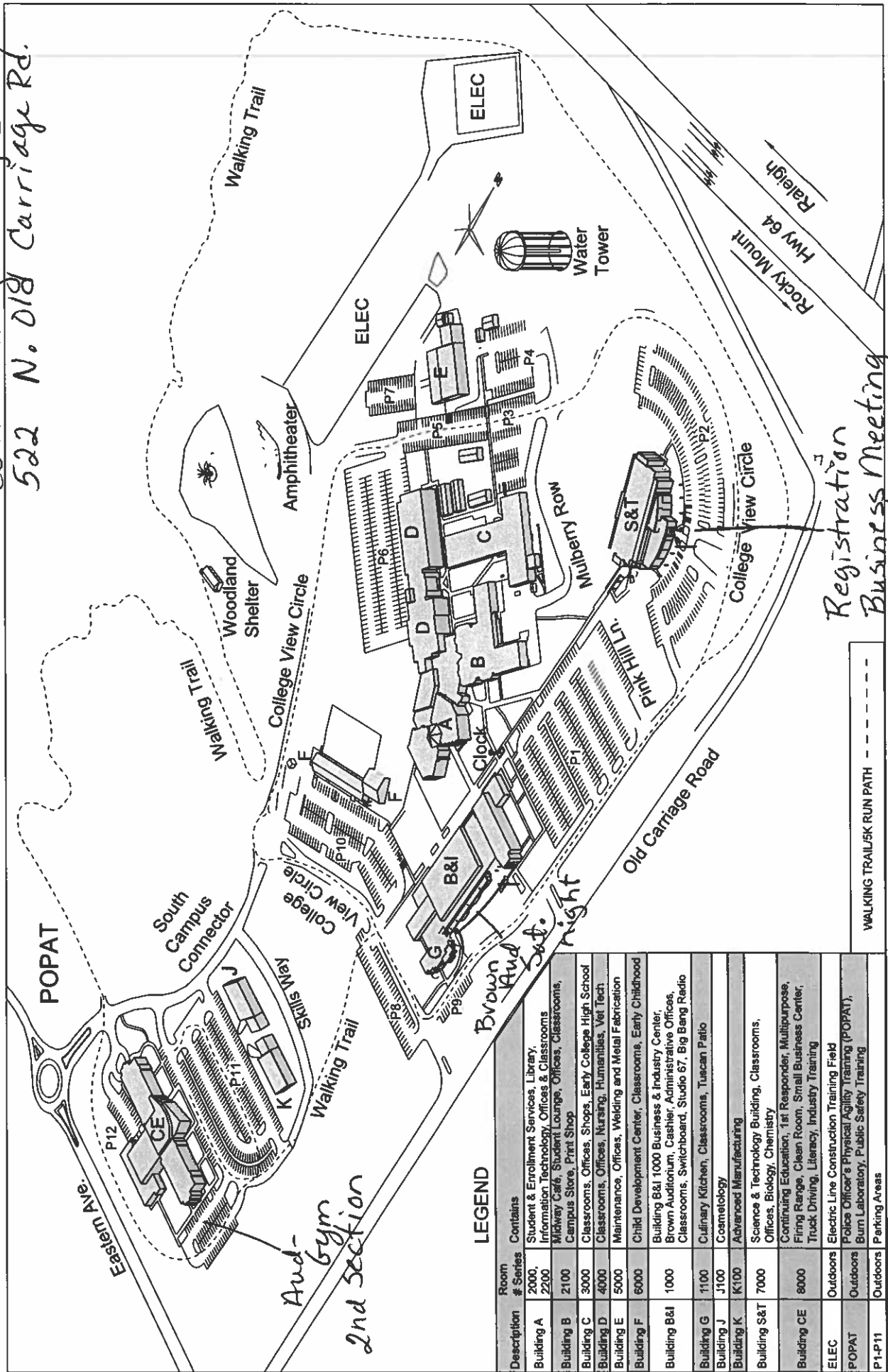
