The Annual Session of Sudan Shriners will be held in the Shrine Auditorium New Bern, NC

lanuary 28, 2012

For the election of Potentate, Divan Officers, Trustees, Imperial Council Representatives, SASA Representatives and New Candidates: the 2012 Budget Approval and the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the temple.

Imperial By-laws Article 325.11: Election Regulations

- (a) **Electioneering.** A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume' consisting of his educational background. his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- (b) **Expenditure Prohibited.** The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- (c) Violation. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.
- (d) Notice. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section. Amend. 2011

She has met and exceeded her goals and expectations. But it came with a devastating tragedy of losing her mother, Donna, one year ago this month at UNC while preparing for her first classes. She started classes in the spring of this year and did very well by making A's in all three courses she took. Her new goals are to graduate from UNC and go on to become a doctor of pediatrics.

On July 22nd, Jesse made her last trip to the Shriners Hospital for Children in Greenville, S.C. The doctors and staff are already missing her beautiful smile and warm personality. Speaking as one of the many Roadrunner drivers, I will certainly miss seeing her. I think of her as a daughter, who at the age of 20, is spreading her wings and headed to new adventures. There is no doubt in my mind that she will succeed.
