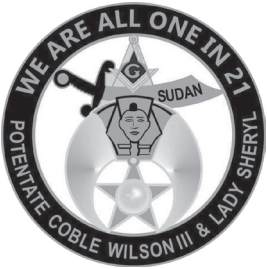

## Overlooked Opportunity

As we begin a new year, the pandemic continues to hold our membership hostage. During our January Winter Ceremonial, we created only 6 new Nobles. We are thankful for these additional 6 Nobles however, having only 6 candidates is a contrast to the 30 plus candidates we normally would have at our Winter Ceremonial and is a leading indicator that we need to deviate from our current practices. Historically we have been relying on a pool of candidates from new "Master Masons", or re-activating those who have found themselves on our NPD list. Currently we have 3577 Sudan Shriners with 27 associates for a total of 3604 Sudan Shriners.

With these challenges, there is another opportunity that we have overlooked, and we should explore and take advantage of. I am reminded of this from a personal experience. A few weeks ago, I was getting out of my truck and I heard someone calling my name. I turned around to find that it was a Brother who continues to be active in the Lodge but let the Shrine go. He told me how much he misses being part of the Shrine and he would like to return and become current. He asked what is required to be re-instated. The answer to this question for when you are asked is to be re-instated and become current in the Shrine, a Noble must be current with their Lodge, he must pay the current year dues, plus the previous year, plus the assessment. That is cheap for re-entry to our Shrine. This example is not an isolated event. There are others like him. We need to think about those lost Nobles from 3, 4 or 5 years ago that left Sudan because they got upset at something or someone, or because they were not active in club activities and lost interest, or did not participate in a unit, or there was a communication failure.

Every Club and Unit in Sudan should take a minute and compile a listing of those Nobles we lost due to these circumstances and contact them. It will be interesting to see the results. When you contact them, listen to their reason for leaving and discuss what has changed and hopefully reach a path forward for their return. Make them realize their presence and interaction is missed and their input is valued. We desperately need them and anticipate their return.

In addition to this approach, our Spring Ceremonial is scheduled for May 14th and 15th in Kinston. The Sudan Membership Team is asked that you contact those Master Masons that are not Shriners and solicit them to petition and become part of our great organization. All we must do is for each Sudan Shriner to strive to create "Just One" new Shriner. Hopefully, with the help of everyone we will have a large class of candidates in Kinston for our 2021 membership drive. Thank you for your help, and I hope to see you in Kinston.

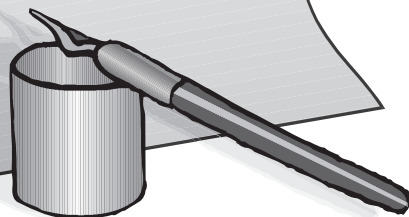

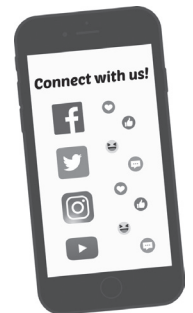
