



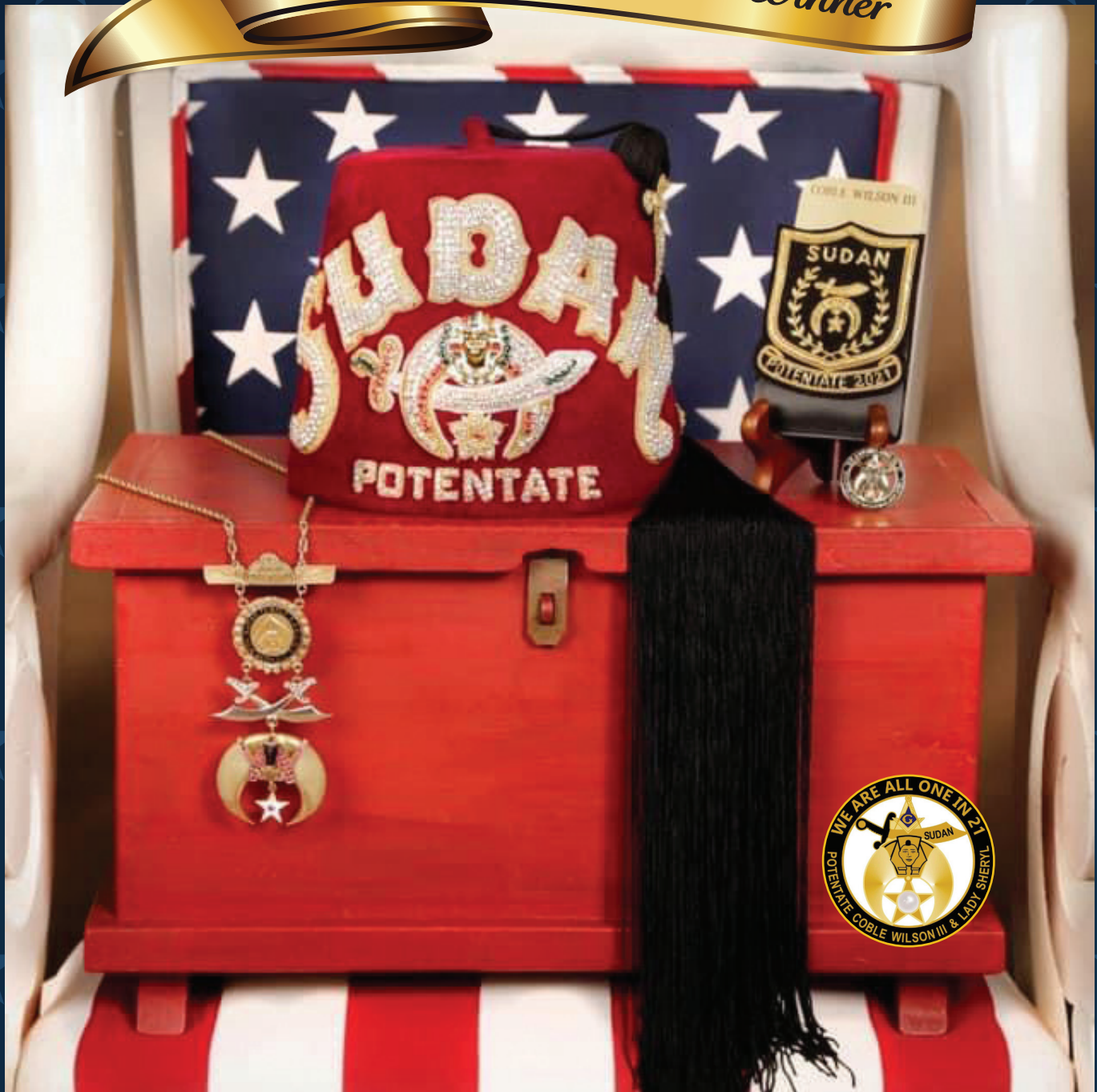

resuming and fundraising activities to help with our vital financial needs and fulfilling our obligation to the Shriners Hospitals for Children. Our One Day Ceremonial in Brunswick County proved to be outstanding, doubling our new candidate count for the year. Restorations are up! Our membership chairman has provided us a great article and thoughts on how we can get better! Sudan definitely showed the South Atlantic Shrine Association that we were most deserving as the "1st Place Divan". A congratulations to all units that participated in the parade. Our Sudan Clowns brought home to Sudan the "Traveling SASA Clown Trophy" for the 15th time.

In July, our Sudan Representatives attended the 147th Shriners Imperial Session and had a big time. The Potentate and Jace competed in the Shriners International Cornhole Tournament and went five rounds before elimination. One of the most significant items on the business agenda was a submission to increase the percapita tax per member from \$30.00 to \$50.00. That item was narrowly defeated and without a doubt will re-appear next year. The percapita tax has not increased at Shriners International since 2015 and took effect in 2016. Membership losses have been horrendous during this same period and the costs of operations has also increased dramatically. Attendance at this annual event was lower than usual with our Canadian neighbors and other International Temples unable to attend due to Covid 19.

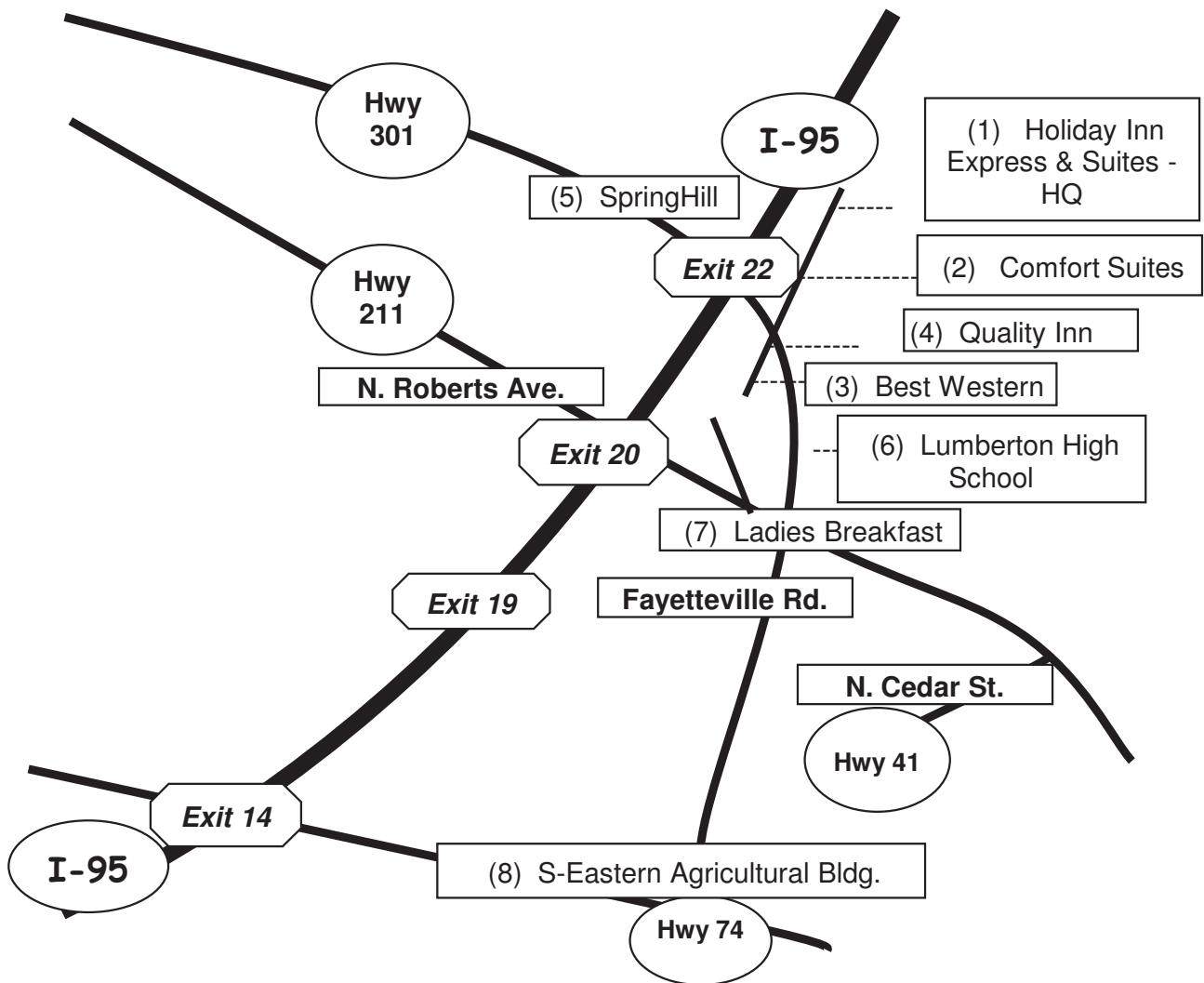

SUDAN SHRINERS RESOLUTION TO DEMOLISH BUILDING

September 10, 2021

WHEREAS, On September 14, 2018, Hurricane Florence ravaged and destroyed by flooding, wind and torrential downpour Sudan Shriners temple, a three-story building located at 403 E Front Street, New Bern, NC


WHEREAS, after diligent attempts with recovery efforts by a major professional disaster recovery team it was determined that the building was not safe to inhabit and was placed off limits by the Sudan Divan, Board of Directors.


WHEREAS, On February 17, 2021, Sudan Shriners employed a certified engineering firm, Smith Engineering and Design, P.A. of Goldsboro to inspect, evaluate and prepare a report on their findings on the suitability for use of, restoration, compliance with all building codes and ADA's (American Disabilities Act) with this structure which was initially constructed in the 1951–1956-time frame.


NOW, THEREFORE, let it be resolved that on September 1, 2021 a written summary report was received from Smith Engineering and Design, P.A. and distributed to the Board of Directors. It has been thoroughly reviewed by the Sudan Shriners Divan, (Board of Directors). Their findings resulted in a unanimous vote that the building should be demolished and the property cleared.


Additionally, the board recommends a phased plan for a new facility which could include (1) establishing a rental agreement for a parking lot, (2) rebuilding on the same property, waterfront lot or build at another location, (3) determine the size of a new facility needed, based on current and future membership needs, (4) and determine funds needed and how to raise those funds.



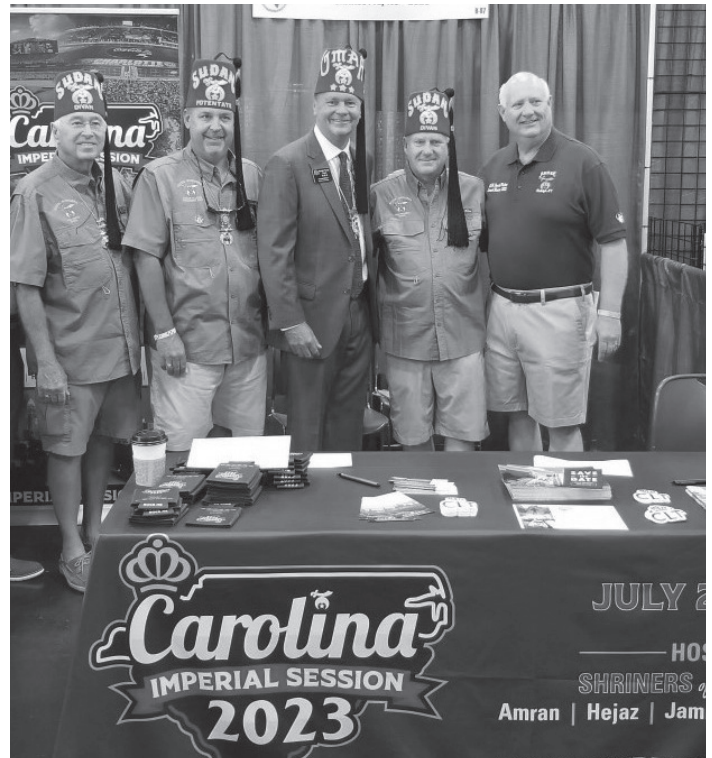

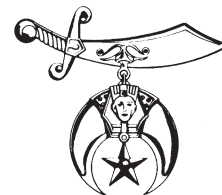

A Glimpse into The Future

Nobles, we just concluded a successful “Cold Sands Ceremonial” at South Brunswick Islands Shrine Club on September 11th. We created sixteen new Sudan Shriners. That doubled our 2021 creations from a total of sixteen prior to our “Cold Sands” to 32 Sudan Shriners year to date. We remain far below our pre-covid creations where we averaged between 75 to 100 new Nobles per year. Currently we have 3547 Sudan Shriners. We have created thirty-two, affiliated four, restored forty-two, with two associations, six demits, three suspensions. The Black Camel has taken ninety-eight of our Nobles, with two associate drops, for a net loss of twenty-nine Nobles for 2021. We still have 175 Nobles remaining on our NPD list. This is our albatross, and the primary reason for our declining membership. We are decreasing membership by around 175 Nobles per year. We must address this re-occurring issue and reverse this downward trend. We will be sending the NPD list to all of Sudan in case there is someone on the list that has not received a contact from the club. When you receive the list, please contact those on the list that you know and urge them to become current.

Using South Brunswick Islands Shrine Club as an example, I have had conversations with those who feel our “Cold Sands” could be a membership opportunity for the future of Sudan. Half of our new Nobles from our “Cold Sands” were from the Southeastern part of Sudan Land. Incorporating more “Cold Sands” throughout Sudan annually could capitalize on those local Master Masons who would rather not endure a traditional Ceremonial weekend. These “Cold Sands” would be chosen within Sudan locations that are remote to the locations where Ceremonials are normally held.

Another idea is if a Shrine Club has several Master Masons that would like to become a Shriner, the club could let it be known and a spontaneous “Cold Sands” could be arranged with the premise those Nobles would participate in the next Ceremonial so they would understand the history and logic of our Sudan Shrine.

Our next opportunity to create new Nobles will be our Fall Ceremonial, November 19th and 20th in Lumberton. Robeson County Shrine Club has been working feverishly preparing for this Ceremonial. Based on the number of Master Masons being raised, we are anticipating a large class of candidates. Please, when you have a Master Mason raised in your Lodge, please solicit him to join the Shrine. We would love to see them become a Sudan Shriner in Lumberton.

Once again, please remind those who are former members who have drifted away from the Shrine for over two years and in good standing they can re-instate their membership for only \$110 and become current and enjoy the benefits of being a Sudan Shriner.

I look forward to seeing in Lumberton. The future of Sudan depends on every one of us.

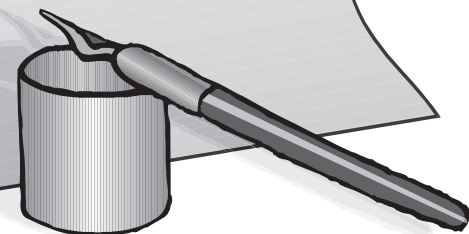

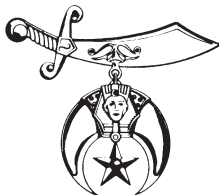

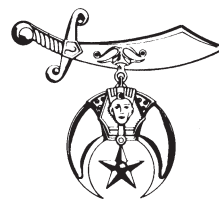
INSHP 2021 Officers

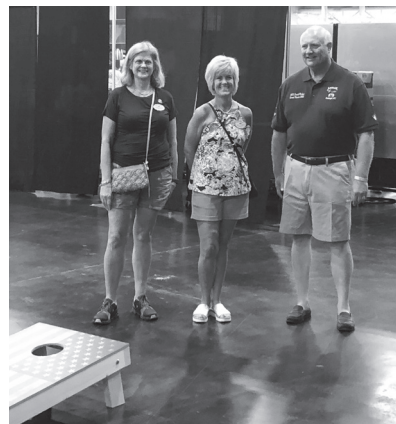



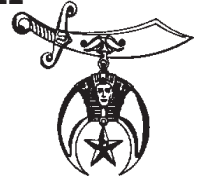
