





resuming and fundraising activities to help with our vital financial needs and fulfilling our obligation to the Shriners Hospitals for Children. Our One Day Ceremonial in Brunswick County proved to be outstanding, doubling our new candidate count for the year. Restorations are up! Our membership chairman has provided us a great article and thoughts on how we can get better! Sudan definitely showed the South Atlantic Shrine Association that we were most deserving as the "1st Place Divan". A congratulations to all units that participated in the parade. Our Sudan Clowns brought home to Sudan the "Traveling SASA Clown Trophy" for the 15th time.

In July, our Sudan Representatives attended the 147th Shriners Imperial Session and had a big time. One of the most significant items on the business agenda was a submission to increase the percapita tax per member from \$30.00 to \$50.00. 

# SUDAN SHRINERS RESOLUTION TO DEMOLISH BUILDING

September 10, 2021

**WHEREAS**, On September 14, 2018, Hurricane Florence ravaged and destroyed by flooding, wind and torrential downpour Sudan Shriners temple, a three-story building located at 403 E Front Street, New Bern, NC

**WHEREAS**, after diligent attempts with recovery efforts by a major professional disaster recovery team it was determined that the building was not safe to inhabit and was placed off limits by the Sudan Divan, Board of Directors.

**WHEREAS,** On February 17, 2021, Sudan Shriners employed a certified engineering firm, Smith Engineering and Design, P.A. of Goldsboro to inspect, evaluate and prepare a report on their findings on the suitability for use of, restoration, compliance with all building codes and ADA's (American Disabilities Act) with this structure which was initially constructed in the 1951–1956-time frame.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, let it be resolved that on September 1, 2021 a written summary report was received from Smith Engineering and Design, P.A. and distributed to the Board of Directors. It has been thoroughly reviewed by the Sudan Shriners Divan, (Board of Directors). Their findings resulted in a unanimous vote that the building should be demolished and the property cleared.

Additionally, the board recommends a phased plan for a new facility which could include (1) establishing a rental agreement for a parking lot, (2) rebuilding on the same property, waterfront lot or build at another location, (3) determine the size of a new facility needed, based on current and future membership needs, (4) and determine funds needed and how to raise those funds.



#### A Glimpse into The Future

Nobles, we just concluded a successful "Cold Sands Ceremonial" at South Brunswick Islands Shrine Club on September 11th. We created sixteen new Sudan Shriners. That doubled our 2021 creations from a total of sixteen prior to our "Cold Sands" to 32 Sudan Shriners year to date. We remain far below our pre-covid creations where we averaged between 75 to 100 new Nobles per year. Currently we have 3547 Sudan Shriners. We have created thirty-two, affiliated four, restored forty-two, with two associations, six demits, three suspensions. The Black Camel has taken ninety-eight of our Nobles, with two associate drops, for a net loss of twenty-nine Nobles for 2021. We still have 175 Nobles remaining on our NPD list. This is our albatross, and the primary reason for our declining membership. We are decreasing membership by around 175 Nobles per year. We must address this re-occurring issue and reverse this downward trend. We will be sending the NPD list to all of Sudan in case there is someone on the list that has not received a contact from the club. When you receive the list, please contact those on the list that you know and urge them to become current.

Using South Brunswick Islands Shrine Club as an example, I have had conversations with those who feel our "Cold Sands" could be a membership opportunity for the future of Sudan. Half of our new Nobles from our "Cold Sands" were from the Southeastern part of Sudan Land. 


